

ARTICULATION AGREEMENT
 Between
MASSACHUSETTS BAY COMMUNITY COLLEGE
 and

 Project Lead the Way: Computer Science

This Agreement is entered into between Massachusetts Bay Community College (“MassBay”) and (_____) High School for articulation of certain course credits in the (_____) High School Project Lead the Way: Computer Science program curriculum.

MassBay will award college credit to (_____) High School students for the courses listed below, subject to the following conditions. Students must:

- have graduated from high school before articulation credit can be granted.
- request articulation credit within two (2) years from their date of high school graduation.
- provide the MassBay Registrar with their official (_____) High School transcript.
- receive a grade of "B" (3.0) or better at (_____) High School for Computer Science Principles and Cybersecurity.
- graduate with a high school cumulative grade point average of "C" (2.5) or better overall.

PLTW Courses	Course equivalencies
Computer Science Principles	CS 110 – Introduction to Computer Science (4 credits)
Cybersecurity	CS 106 Security Awareness (2 credits)

A student will be awarded college credit for the courses above upon receipt of the following documentation from (_____) High School:

1. A certification signed by the High School PLTW Computer Science Director which establishes the student's eligibility for credits under the terms of this agreement and verifies his/her successful completion of the (_____) High School PLTW Computer Science program.
2. An official transcript of the student's coursework and grades which verifies successful completion of the PLTW Computer Science program.

It is the responsibility and obligation of the parties, (_____) High School and MassBay, to notify one another in writing of any substantive changes in curriculum, instructional methodology, or personnel which could affect the terms of this Agreement.

This Agreement will be reviewed bi-annually and may be revised by mutual agreement. The Agreement is expected to continue in force indefinitely but may be terminated by either party with at least one year's notice.
